

Syrups

- Syrups are the sweet, viscous, concentrated aqueous solutions of sucrose or other sugars in water or any other suitable aqueous vehicle.
- **when syrup containing:**
 - → purified water alone 🖈 simple syrup
 - → medicinal substance ⇒ medicated syrup
 - → aromatic or flavored substance

 → flavoring syrup
- 4 Syrups are uses for masking the bad taste as vehicle
- \blacksquare It is made by dissolving sucrose 85 % (w/v) in boiling water.
- ♣ To retard crystallization of sucrose may be added:
 - → glycerin
 - → sorbitol
 - → polyhydric alcohols
- ♣ Should be prepared the syrup in small quantities which can be used within a few months.
- ♣ If prepared in large quantities must be preserved well to prevent contamination by added some preservatives like:
 - → glycerin
 - → Methyl and propyl paraben (0.05%)
 - benzoic acid
 - Sodium benzoate (0.2%)
 - ♣ Alcohol (15-20%)
- \clubsuit Storage: syrups should be stored in well-closed container and at a temperature not more than 30°C.
